COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Milford Miami Ministry's mission and programs are focused on basic needs of nutrition, housing, warmth, and economic stability. Our two largest programs are a food pantry and an emergency financial assistance program...

Food pantry: Families living in the Milford/Miami Township service area are eligible to visit the food pantry every 21 days. A family of 4 (the average size family seeking assistance) receives about 60 lbs. of food per visit, equal to about 60 meals. In addition to non-perishables (e.g., soap, paper goods), each family receives 1/2 gallon of milk, 1 dozen eggs, a meat item, and bread/baked goods. Families can also receive cleaning and personal care items.

Emergency financial assistance: Families struggling to pay rent or utilities or buy prescription medicines seek financial assistance to avoid eviction or having essential utilities disconnected. Residents provide documentation of need, such as a disconnect notice from the utility company or notice to leave the premises from their landlord. The amount of assistance is determined by the client's need and funds available at the time of the request.

2023 COMMUNITY IMPACT

Food pantry: Provided 105,000 meals to 2,043 households (6,449 people, including 2,539 children). An average of 170 families were assisted each month throughout 2023.

Emergency financial assistance: Processed 393 requests for assistance, including 207 requests for utilities and 186 for rent/mortgage. A total of 387 disbursements totaling \$126,007 were paid, which was an average of \$325.60.

Thanksgiving and Christmas: 200 Thanksgiving meals and 224 Christmas meals were provided along with 2,800 Christmas gifts for children.

School backpacks: Distributed 420 backpacks to students attending Milford Exempted Village School District schools.

Share What You Wear: Provided clothing items to 1,123 families consisting of 4,040 people.

COMMUNITY PARTNERS

Milford Miami Ministry consists of 22 member churches, many individuals who serve as donors and volunteers, the Milford Village School District, and the general Milford/Miami community. Milford Miami Ministry has been a member of the Milford Chamber of Commerce since March 2013.
